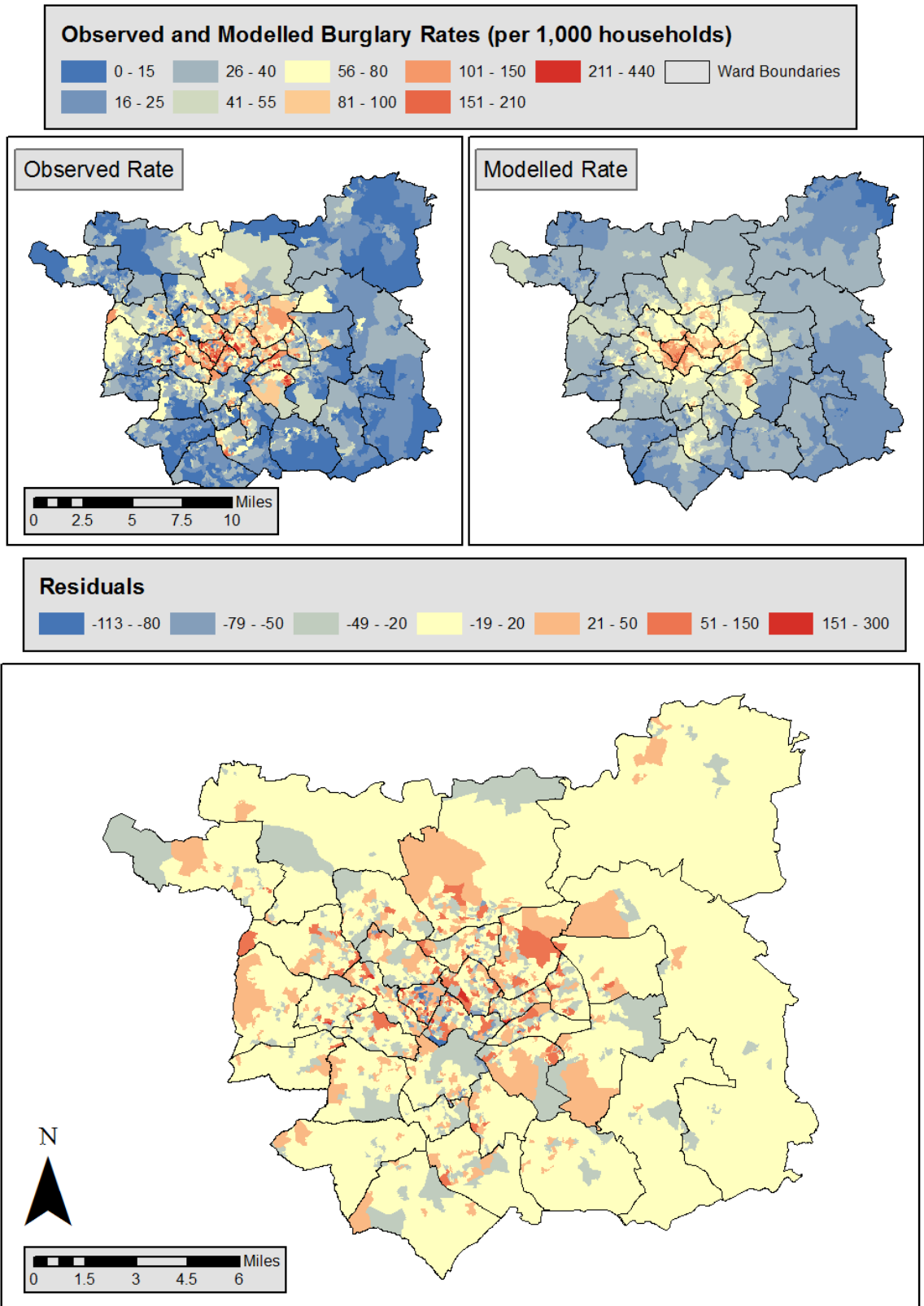


Figure 1 Observed and modelled burglary rates with residuals
