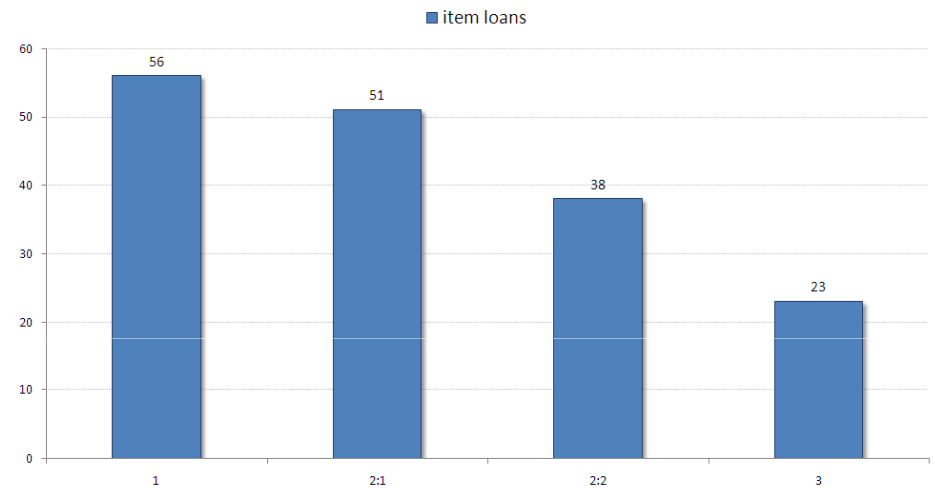
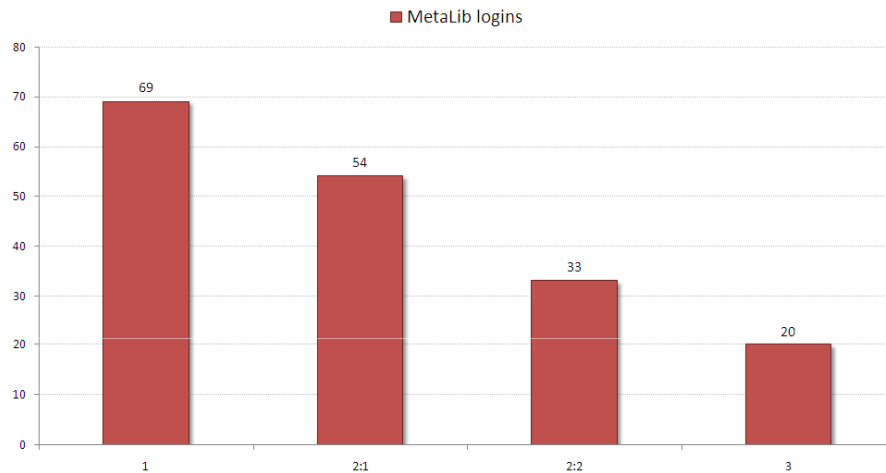

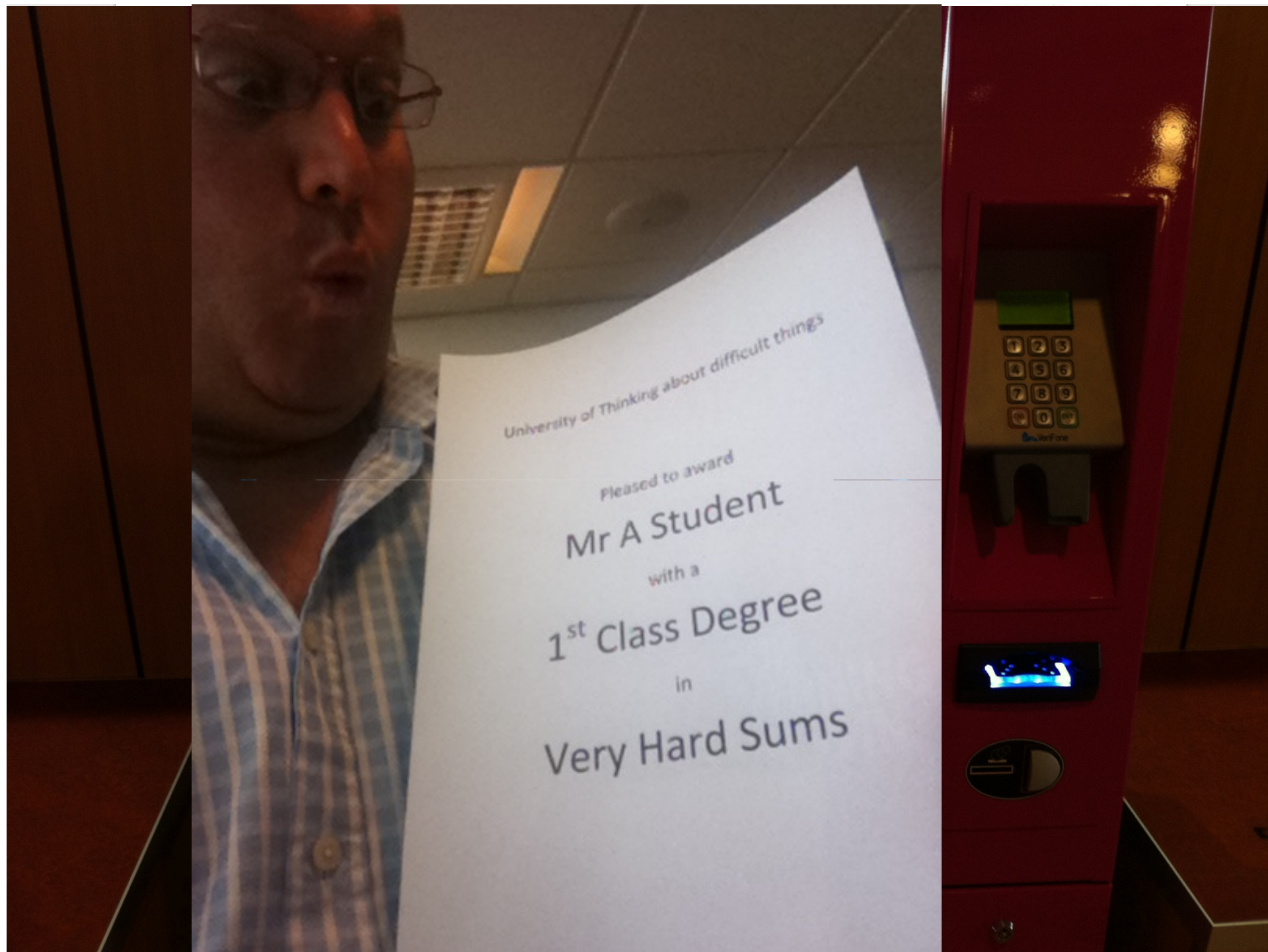
# Library Impact Data Project
